MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Michael R. Doody appeals from a judgment entered in the District Court (Caribou, *Daigle, J.*) awarding Cavalry SPV I, LLC \$4803.96 plus interest of \$3326.57. Doody contends that there was insufficient evidence for the court to determine that he authorized charges made to his credit card. Contrary to Doody's contention, there is competent evidence to support the court's finding that he authorized charges made to his credit card. *See Advanced Constr. Corp. v. Pilecki*, 2006 ME 84, ¶ 14, 901 A.2d 189, 195.
