MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Bruce V. Mayberry appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Augusta, *Vafiades, J.*) finding that he had committed a speeding violation. Mayberry contends that the District Court lacked subject matter jurisdiction because the officer who gave him the ticket failed to present it to the Violations Bureau for service in accordance with 4 M.R.S. § 171-A(1) (2006) and M.R. Civ. P. 80F(b), and because the officer did not swear to its validity under oath. We disagree and reassert our reasoning in *State v. Mayberry*, 2001 ME 176, ¶¶ 8-9, 787 A.2d 135, 137. The State's request for sanctions is denied.
