MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of Kaci Lee E.V. appeals from a jeopardy order entered in the District Court (Lewiston, *Lawrence, J.*) finding that the child is in jeopardy because the mother's escalating anger and frustration posed a threat of serious harm to the child. *See* 22 M.R.S. § 4002(6), (10) (2005). Contrary to the mother's contention, the evidence was sufficient for the court's finding of jeopardy.
