MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The father of Michael P. appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Newport, *MacMichael*, *J*.) terminating his parental rights pursuant to 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2) (2006). Contrary to the father's contentions, the record supports the court's findings by clear and convincing evidence, and the findings are sufficient to support at least one ground of parental unfitness and the conclusion that termination of his parental rights is in the child's best interest. *See In re Thomas D.*, 2004 ME 104, ¶ 21, 854 A.2d 195, 201.
