MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother appeals from an order entered in the District Court (Bangor, *Gunther, J.*) terminating her parental rights to Mariah D., Nicholas S., and Teagan D. pursuant to 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2) (2006). Contrary to the mother's contentions, the court did not fail to find that termination is in the children's best interests. *See In re Amanda H.*, 2007 ME 43, ¶ 3, 917 A.2d 1120, 1120-21; 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2)(a). Furthermore, the record supports the court's findings by clear and convincing evidence of at least one ground of parental unfitness and that termination of the mother's parental rights is in the children's best interests. *See In re Thomas D.*, 2004 ME 104, ¶¶ 21, 38, 854 A.2d 195, 201, 207. The court did not abuse its discretion in reaching its ultimate conclusion that termination is in the children's best interests. *See In re Thomas H.*, 2005 ME 123, ¶ 16, 889 A.2d 297, 301.
