#### MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Christopher T. Gauthier appeals from judgments entered in the District Court (Springvale, *Stavros, J.*) granting his attorney's motion for withdrawal and (Biddeford, *Janelle, J.*) only offering to grant a continuance on the condition that his wife provisionally relocate with their two minor children pending the outcome at trial. Contrary to Christopher's contention, neither the motion court nor the trial court abused its discretion. *See Bradshaw v. Bradshaw*, 2005 ME 14, ¶ 10, 866 A.2d 839, 843; *Provenzano v. Deloge*, 2000 ME 149, ¶ 11, 755 A.2d 549, 551.

The trial court's findings as to custody and relocation were reasonable and in the best interests of the children. *See Huff v. Huff*, 444 A.2d 396, 398 (Me 1982).
