MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Katherine R. McClellan appeals from a judgment of conviction of assault (Class D) 17-A M.R.S. § 207 (1)(A) (2006), entered in the District Court (West Bath, *Field, J.*). Contrary to McClellan's contention, the evidence, when viewed in the light most favorable to the State, was sufficient for a fact-finder to rationally find each element of the offense beyond a reasonable doubt. *See State v. Pierce*, 2006 ME 75, ¶ 16, 899 A.2d 801, 804.
