MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Ronald J. Strong appeals from an order entered in the Superior Court (Cumberland County, *Mills*, *J*.) denying his motion to modify or vacate his sentence for judgments of conviction for violation of a protective order (Class D), 19-A M.R.S. § 4011(1)(A) (2006). We dismiss the appeal because Strong's motion to modify or vacate his sentence is untimely as it was filed more than a year after the sentence was imposed. M.R. Crim. P. 35(a).
