MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Gregory C. Luck appeals from the judgment of the District Court (Biddeford, *D. Kennedy, J.*) upon his complaint for determination of paternity and parental rights and responsibilities. On appeal, Luck challenges the court's allocation of parental rights and responsibilities and its determinations regarding child support, attorney fees, and payment of guardian ad litem costs. Contrary to Luck's assertions, the record reflects that the District Court afforded Luck a full opportunity to be heard and then carefully and thoroughly considered the matters in reaching its decision. The record reflects no error of law or abuse of discretion

in the District Court's determinations regarding allocation of parental rights and responsibilities, child support, attorney fees, and responsibility for payment of guardian ad litem costs. *See Grenier v. Grenier*, 2006 ME 99, ¶ 20, 904 A.2d 403, 408; *Dargie v. Dargie*, 2001 ME 127, ¶¶ 18-31, 778 A.2d 353, 358-60.
