MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Amy L. Greenwald appeals the judgment of the District Court (Lewiston, *Beliveau, J.*) which, after hearing, denied her motion to modify the order of parental rights and responsibilities and her separate motion for contempt. Contrary to Greenwald's contentions, the record fully supports the District Court's factual findings. *See Grenier v. Grenier*, 2006 ME 99, ¶ 20, 904 A.2d 403, 408. The record also demonstrates that the District Court did not abuse its discretion in not recusing and not appointing a guardian ad litem upon Greenwald's request. *See Estate of Dineen*, 1998 ME 268, ¶¶ 8-9, 721 A.2d 185, 188.
