MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Edmond E. Garnier appeals from a judgment of the Violations Bureau (Augusta, *Romei, J.*) finding him to have committed the offense of speeding, driving forty-one miles-per-hour in a twenty-five mile-per-hour zone, in violation of 29-A M.R.S. § 2073(3) (2006). Contrary to Garnier's contentions, the evidence in the record, though contested, is sufficient to support each of the elements of the speeding charge. *See State v. Moores*, 2006 ME 139, ¶¶ 7-9, 910 A.2d 373, 375.
