MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Norman Hutchinson appeals from the judgment of the District Court (Rumford, *McElwee, J.*) dismissing his protection from harassment action filed against the Maine Revenue Services. Hutchinson's action was filed after the State attempted to recover past due income taxes from him, and has no basis in fact or law. 5 M.R.S. § 4651(2) (2006). The District Court acted appropriately in dismissing the action.
