## MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Norman A. Hutchinson and Rita M. Hutchinson appeal from the judgment of foreclosure and sale entered by the District Court (Rumford, *McElwee, J.*) following the grant of a motion for summary judgment. The court ordered a foreclosure and sale of the Hutchinsons' property upon finding that they had defaulted in their payment obligations under the mortgage. The Hutchinsons present a number of claims asserting impropriety of the foreclosure action based on constitutional provisions and historical events, taken out of context. However, their assertions do not raise any genuine issue of material fact with regard to the

essential claims in support of the motion for summary judgment. Accordingly, entry of summary judgment by the District Court was appropriate. *See Reliance Nat'l Indem. v. Knowles Indus. Servs., Corp.*, 2005 ME 29, ¶ 7, 868 A.2d 220, 224.
