MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The father of Katalina C. appeals from a judgment entered in the Superior Court (Penobscot, *A. Murray, D.C.J.*) terminating his parental rights to Katalina pursuant to 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2) (2006). Contrary to the father's contentions, the court rationally could have found clear and convincing evidence in the record to support its determinations that (1) the father was unable to protect Katalina from jeopardy and these circumstances were unlikely to change within a time reasonably calculated to meet her needs, and (2) termination of the father's rights to Katalina was in her best interests. 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2); *In Re Marcus S.*, 2007 ME 24, ¶ 6, 916 A.2d 225, 227; *In Re Thomas H.*, 2005 ME 123, ¶ 16, 889 A.2d 297, 301.
