MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Robin D. Robinson appeals from a judgment entered in the Superior Court (Kennebec County, *Marden, J.*) after a bench trial finding her liable to Bianca T. Robinson for \$6000. Robin argues that the trial court erred as a matter of law by not finding that Bianca's complaint was barred by the statute of limitations pursuant to 14 M.R.S. § 752 (2006). Because Robin failed to move the trial court for findings of fact or conclusions of law pursuant to M.R. Civ. P. 52(a), we assume that the trial court made sufficient factual findings to support its conclusion of law. *Associated Builders, Inc. v. Oczkowski*, 2002 ME 115, ¶ 11,

801 A.2d 1008, 1011. Accordingly, we affirm the judgment, assuming, as we must, that the trial court made sufficient findings to support its conclusion that the statute of limitations did not bar Bianca's cause of action.
