MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Michael J. Dee appeals from that portion of the judgment of the Superior Court (Cumberland County, *Crowley, J.*) that denied his motion for a judgment on the pleadings, granted the State's motion for a judgment on the pleadings and, in effect, upheld the constitutionality of various laws prohibiting the private growing and possession of marijuana. The Superior Court's judgment upholding the constitutionality of these laws in the face of Dee's challenge was soundly based in state and federal precedent cited in the Superior Court's judgment.
