MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Brian D. Peterson appeals from a summary judgment entered in the District Court (Portland, *Eggert, J.*) in favor of Palisades Collections, LLC in its action to collect a credit card debt. Contrary to Peterson's contentions, the review of the record demonstrates that the claims regarding the amount of the debt and the authority of Palisades Collections to undertake collection of the debt, as successor to Citibank, are adequately supported in the record of the summary judgment proceedings, and review of that record does not demonstrate any other error of law in the District Court's consideration and entry of summary judgment. *See* M.R.

Civ. P. 56(e), (h)(2), (4); *Levine v. R.B.K. Caly Corp.*, 2001 ME 77, ¶ 6, 770 A.2d 653, 655-56.
