MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Mahad Dahir Ahmed appeals from a judgment of conviction of gross sexual assault (Class A), 17-A M.R.S. § 253(1)(A) (2006), unlawful sexual contact (Class B), 17-A M.R.S. § 255-A(1)(P) (2006), and assault (Class D), 17-A M.R.S. § 207(1)(A) (2006) entered in the Superior Court (Androscoggin County, *Delahanty, J.*) upon a jury verdict finding him guilty. Contrary to Ahmed's contention, the evidence, when viewed in the light most favorable to the State, was sufficient for a fact-finder to rationally find each element of all these offenses beyond a reasonable doubt. *State v. Pierce*, 2006 ME 75, ¶ 16, 899 A.2d 801, 804.
