MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Paul Krippendorf appeals from a judgment entered in the District Court (Biddeford, *J. Kennedy, J.*) granting Patricia Peck's motion to enforce a divorce judgment by appointing a special master to organize the sale of the parties' real estate. Contrary to Krippendorf's contentions, his procedural due process rights were not violated because he had notice, opportunity to be heard at the enforcement hearing, and was represented by counsel, *see Doggett v. Town of Gouldsboro*, 2002 ME 175, ¶ 3, 9, 812 A.2d 256, 257-58, 59. Finally, competent evidence existed to justify the court's conclusion that the parties were unable to

cooperate to carry out the court's divorce judgment. *See Advanced Constr. Corp. v. Pilecki*, 2006 ME 84, ¶ 14, 901 A.2d 189, 195.
