MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The parents of Karen H. appeal from a judgment entered in the District Court (Belfast, *Worth, J.*) terminating their parental rights pursuant to 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2) (2006). Contrary to the parents' contentions, the record supports the court's findings by clear and convincing evidence of at least one ground of parental unfitness for each parent and that termination of the parents' parental rights is in the child's best interest, *see In re Thomas D.*, 2004 ME 104, ¶¶ 21, 38, 854 A.2d 195, 201, 207.
