MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Richard M. Kuhaneck appeals from a civil contempt judgment entered in the District Court (Bangor, *Murray, A., D.C.J.*). The court found Kuhaneck in contempt for violating a court-ordered child contact schedule regarding the minor child of Kuhaneck and Susan K. Benson. Contrary to Kuhaneck's contention, the District Court did not err in finding by clear and convincing evidence that he failed to timely exchange the child with Benson in accordance with the schedule and did not abuse its discretion in finding him in contempt because he failed to do so. *See*

M.R. Civ. P. 66(d)(2)(D); *Pratt v. Spaulding*, 2003 ME 56, ¶ 10, 822 A.2d 1183,
1186.
