## MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

James A. Hopkins appeals from a dismissal of his protection from harassment complaint against Donald Webber entered in the District Court (Machias, *Romei, J.*). Contrary to Hopkins's contentions, the court did not abuse its discretion in denying Hopkins's motion for recusal, *see In re Kaleb C.*, 2002 ME 65, ¶ 5, 795 A.2d 71, 74; did not lack jurisdiction to consider Hopkins's protection from harassment complaint, *see City of Biddeford v. Holland*, 2005 ME 121, ¶ 6, 886 A.2d 1281, 1284; and did not abuse its discretion or clearly err in admitting evidence alleged to be hearsay, *see State v. Bridges*, 2003 ME 103, ¶ 39, 829 A.2d 247, 258. In addition, Hopkins has not demonstrated that a finding of harassment is compelled by the evidence, *see Westleigh* 

v. Conger, 2000 ME 134, ¶ 12, 755 A.2d 518, 520, or that the court's finding that he had not met his burden is in error because of the finding's effect on his son and girlfriend, see Holland v. Sebunya, 2000 ME 160, ¶ 9 n.6, 759 A.2d 205, 209.
