MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Douglas N. Young appeals from a conviction for assault (Class D), 17-A M.R.S. § 207(1)(A) (2006), entered in the Superior Court (Hancock County, *Jabar, J.*) following a jury trial. Contrary to Young's contention, and viewing the evidence in the light most favorable to the State, sufficient record evidence exists to support a finding beyond a reasonable doubt that Young committed each element of assault. *See State v. Bouchard*, 2005 ME 106, ¶ 10, 881 A.2d 1130, 1134.
