MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Jeffrey A. Frederick appeals from a judgment of divorce against Ami S. Frederick and the denial of his motion to reopen the evidence entered in District Court (Farmington, *McElwee, J.*). Contrary to Jeffrey's contentions, the court did not err in imputing income to him based on his reduction in living expenses resulting from his cohabitation with another person, *see* 19-A M.R.S. § 951-A(5)(Q) (2006); *Eastman v. Eastman-Veres*, 1997 ME 26, ¶ 10, 690 A.2d 494, 496, and did not abuse its discretion by denying his motion to reopen the evidence, *In re Danielle S.*, 2004 ME 19, ¶ 2, 844 A.2d 1148, 1149; M.R. Civ. P. 43(j). To the extent Jeffrey raises other challenges to the judgment or the

proceedings in the District Court, they are without merit, however, we decline to impose sanctions. *See Oliver v. City of Rockland*, 1998 ME 88, ¶ 11 n.7, 710 A.2d 905, 908.
