#### MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Amanda R. Glazier appeals from a divorce judgment entered in the District Court (Waterville, *MacMichael, J.*) granting her and Thomas B. Glazier a divorce and allocating the personal property and debts of the parties. Contrary to Amanda's contention, the court did not abuse its discretion in allocating to her the debts in her name. *See Kapler v. Kapler*, 2000 ME 131, ¶ 8, 755 A.2d 502, 506; 19-A M.R.S. § 953 (2006). Furthermore, the court did not err in failing to address another marital debt in its judgment for which the evidence was disputed and no

motion for findings or reconsideration was made. *See Bonville v. Bonville*, 2006 ME 3, ¶ 15, 890 A.2d 263, 267.
