#### MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Pursuant to 5 M.R.S. § 11008 (2006) and M.R. Civ. P. 80C(m), Dana Short appeals from a judgment of the Superior Court (Somerset County, *Jabar*, *J*.) affirming the decision of the Secretary of State, Bureau of Motor Vehicles (*Naiman*, *Hearing Examiner*), suspending Short's driver's license for operating a motor vehicle with an excessive blood-alcohol level. *See* 29-A M.R.S. § 2453 (2006). Contrary to Short's contentions, sufficient evidence in the record supports the hearing examiner's finding that Short was operating a motor vehicle with a blood-alcohol level of 0.08% or more. *See id.* § 2453(2), (3), (8); *Street v. Bd. of* 

Licensing of Auctioneers, 2006 ME 6, ¶ 8, 889 A.2d 319, 321; see also State v. Allen, 2006 ME 20, ¶ 27, 892 A.2d 447, 455; Adelman v. Town of Baldwin, 2000 ME 91, ¶ 14, 750 A.2d 577, 583.
