MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Larry J. Collins appeals from a judgment of the Superior Court (Androscoggin County, *Gorman, J.*) determining that he must register as a lifetime registrant under the Sex Offender Registration and Notification Act of 1999. 34-A M.R.S. §§ 11203(8)(B), 11222(1) (2006). Contrary to Collins's contention that he should be designated as a ten-year registrant pursuant to 34-A M.R.S. § 11203(5) (2006), the plain language of subsection 11203(8)(B) unambiguously indicates that Collins's convictions qualify him for lifetime registration. *See First Union Nat'l Bank v. Curtis*, 2005 ME 108, ¶ 8, 882 A.2d 796, 798.
