MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Keith A. Ayotte appeals from a judgment of conviction for aggravated assault (Class B), 17-A M.R.S. § 208(1)(B) (2007), and criminal threatening with a dangerous weapon (Class C), 17-A M.R.S. §§ 209(1), 1252(4) (2007), entered in the Superior Court (Hancock County, *Cuddy, J.*) following a jury trial. Contrary to Ayotte's contentions, the court did not clearly err or exceed its discretion in admitting a photograph of a knife that was identical to the knife Ayotte used in committing the offenses, in excluding evidence of a subsequent unrelated arrest of the victim, or in admitting the testimony of the physician's assistant who treated the victim. *See State v. Mills*, 2006 ME 134, ¶ 8, 910 A.2d 1053, 1056.
