MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Robert A. Williams appeals from a judgment of conviction of assault (Class D), 17-A M.R.S. § 207(1)(A) (2007), entered in the District Court (Portland, *M. Kennedy, J.*) after a nonjury trial. Because the State agrees with Williams that he was not advised of his right to counsel and the dangers of proceeding to trial pro se, as required by *State v. Watson*, 2006 ME 80, 900 A.2d 702, we vacate his conviction and remand the matter to the District Court.
