MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Amber Yurchick appeals from a judgment of conviction of two counts of arson (Class A), 17-A M.R.S. § 802(1)(B)(2) (2007); and one count each of burglary (Class B), 17-A M.R.S. § 401(1)(B)(4) (2007); assault (Class D), 17-A M.R.S. § 207(1)(A) (2007); terrorizing (Class D), 17-A M.R.S. § 210(1)(A) (2007); and criminal trespass (Class D), 17-A M.R.S. § 402(1)(A) (2007), entered in the Superior Court (Hancock County, *Cuddy, J.*) after a jury found her guilty. Contrary to her contention, the court's jury instruction did not result in prejudicial error and did correctly and fairly inform the jury. *See State v. Gantnier*, 2008 ME 40, ¶ 13, 942 A.2d 1191, 1195.
