MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The parents of David H. appeal an order of the District Court (Belfast, *Nivison, C.J.*) terminating their parental rights to their son. Contrary to the parents' contentions, the court could reasonably have been persuaded, based on competent record evidence, that it was proved to be highly probable that: (1) the mother and father are unable to protect the child from jeopardy and that the circumstances are unlikely to change within a time reasonably calculated to meet the child's needs; and (2) termination of the parents' parental rights is in the child's best interest. *See In re Serena C.*, 650 A.2d 1343, 1344 (Me. 1994).
