MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Augustus J. Edgerton appeals the judgment of the District Court (Rockland, *Anderson, J.*) finding him guilty of the charge of operating a motor vehicle after license suspension, 29-A M.R.S. § 2412-A(1-A)(A) (2007). Contrary to Edgerton's contentions, although Edgerton claims that the State's evidence was based on a mistaken observation, there is sufficient evidence in the record to support the court's findings beyond a reasonable doubt. On review, we must consider the evidence in the light most favorable to the court's judgment entered after trial. *State v. Smen*, 2006 ME 40, ¶ 7, 895 A.2d 319, 321.
