MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The father of Kimberly D. and Timothy D. appeals from the judgment of the District Court (Machias, *Romei, J.*) terminating his parental rights to the children. He contends that the evidence is insufficient to support the court's findings of parental unfitness. Review of the transcript of the proceedings indicates more than sufficient evidence to support the court's findings, to the clear and convincing evidence standard, that the father was unable or unwilling to protect the children from jeopardy, that the circumstances are unlikely to change within a time reasonably calculated to meet the needs of the children and that termination of parental rights was in the children's best interests. *In re Thomas H.*, 2005 ME 123, ¶¶ 16-18, 889 A.2d 297, 301-02; *In re Marpheen C.*, 2002 ME 170, ¶¶ 5-6, 812 A.2d 972, 973-74.
