MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Shary J. Jones appeals from the judgment of the District Court (Bridgton, *Cantara, J.*) awarding parental rights and responsibilities regarding the parties' four-year-old daughter. Jones contends that the court erred in awarding primary residence of their daughter to Matthew H. Lerman and making Lerman solely responsible for decision-making regarding healthcare treatment for their daughter within what otherwise are shared parental rights and responsibilities. The available documentary evidence fully supports the court's judgment. Further, where no transcript or alternative record of the proceedings has been provided, we must infer that the record of the two days of hearings in this case would support the findings and conclusions reached by the trial court and the discretionary decisions made with regard to any issues of evidence or procedure. *See Jefts v. Dennis*, 2007 ME 129, ¶ 7, 931 A.2d 1055, 1057.
