MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The father of Raye Lynn W. appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Machias, *Romei, J.*) terminating his parental rights. Contrary to his contentions, the court did not clearly err in finding that the father is unwilling or unable to protect Raye Lynn W. from jeopardy and that these circumstances are unlikely to change within a time which is reasonably calculated to meet her needs, or that the father is unwilling or unable to take responsibility for Raye Lynn W. within a time which is reasonably calculated to meet her needs, or that the father is unwilling or unable to take responsibility for Raye Lynn W. within a time which is reasonably calculated to meet her needs, or that the father had failed to make a good faith effort to rehabilitate and reunify with Raye Lynn W., *In re Marcus S.*, 2007 ME 24, ¶ 6, 916 A.2d 225, 227, and the court could have reasonably been persuaded on the basis of the evidence in the record that the required factual findings were highly probable, *In re Thomas H.*, 2005 ME 123, ¶ 18, 889 A.2d 297, 302.
