MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Harrison A. Bispham III appeals from the judgment of the Kennebec County Probate Court (*Mitchell, J.*) denying his M.R. Prob. P. 60(b) motion for relief from an earlier judgment on an order to show cause. In that judgment, the court had elected to accept late accountings filed by Bispham as conservator for his daughter, Kathryn, and had elected not to hold Bispham in contempt, despite his repeated refusals to provide the court with the accountings in a timely manner. Review of the record reflects that the court acted appropriately, and with commendable restraint, in addressing Bispham's claims both at the hearing on the order to show cause and in review of Bispham's motion for relief from judgment, which included a motion for a late filing of a motion to reconsider. *See Keybank Nat'l Ass'n v. Sargent*, 2000 ME 153, ¶ 13, 758 A.2d 528, 533.
