MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of Destiny and Shacory V. appeals from a judgment entered by the District Court (Dover-Foxcroft, *Stitham, J.*) finding the children to be in jeopardy pursuant to 22 M.R.S. § 4035(2) (2007). Contrary to the mother's contentions, the evidence admitted at the jeopardy hearing was sufficient for the court to rationally find, by a preponderance of the evidence, that her substance abuse and the allowance by her and the father of drug paraphernalia in the home they shared with Destiny and Shacory deprived the children of adequate shelter, supervision, or care. 22 M.R.S. § 4002(6)(B) (2007); *see In re Dakota P.*, 2005 ME 2, ¶ 15, 863 A.2d 280, 285.
