#### MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The father and mother of William P. appeal from a judgment entered in the District Court (Newport, *MacMichael*, *J*.) terminating their parental rights to William pursuant to 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2) (2007). Contrary to their arguments, the court rationally could have found by clear and convincing evidence that: (1) both parents are unable to protect William from jeopardy and the circumstances are unlikely to change within a time frame reasonably calculated to meet his needs; (2) both parents are unable to take responsibility for William within a time frame reasonably calculated to meet his needs; and (3) termination of parental rights is in William's best interests.

Contrary to the father's contention, the court made specific findings of fact that provided an adequate basis for review. *See In re Kenneth H.*, 1997 ME 48, ¶ 5, 690 A.2d 984, 985; *In re Amber B.*, 597 A.2d 937, 938 (Me. 1991).
