MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Edward J. Greenblatt appeals from the judgment of the District Court (Lincoln, *Stitham, J.*) entering default judgment and summary judgment for CUNA Mutual Group, Inc. in its action to collect from Greenblatt sums paid on forged checks. Greenblatt contends that the court erred in (1) not requiring CUNA to provide discovery to him, and (2) entering judgment, in violation of his Fifth Amendment right to remain silent, after he did not cooperate in discovery or properly respond to the motion for default or motion for summary judgment. The court did not err in entering default judgment and summary judgment following Greenblatt's failure to comply, in good faith, with the court's discovery orders, *see Harris v. Soley*, 2000 ME 150, ¶¶ 8-18, 756 A.2d 499, 504-06, and his failure to file any timely opposition to the motion for default and motion for summary judgment filed by CUNA Mutual Group, Inc., *see* M.R. Civ. P. 7(c)(3).
