MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Michael A. Walls appeals from a judgment of conviction of violation of a protective order (Class D), 19-A M.R.S. § 4011(1) (2007), entered in the Superior Court (Knox County, *Wheeler, J.*) upon a jury verdict finding him guilty.

Contrary to Walls's contention, the jury rationally could have found, based on evidence in the record, that the State proved the elements of its case beyond a reasonable doubt. *See State v. Bouchard*, 2005 ME 106, ¶ 10, 881 A.2d 1130, 1134. Additionally, a statement by the prosecutor impeaching Walls's credibility was not obvious error. *See M. Bar R. 3.7(e)(2)(v); State v. Winslow*, 2007 ME

124, ¶ 18, 930 A.2d 1080, 1085 (stating that an unpreserved claim of prosecutorial misconduct is reviewed for obvious error).
