### MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

West Side Neighbors appeals from a judgment of the Superior Court (Kennebec County, *Studstrup*, *J*.) dismissing its M.R. Civ. P. 80B complaint as an untimely challenge to the grant of a variance by the Board of Zoning Appeals that supported the issuance of a subdivision permit to Roncalli Apartments, Inc.<sup>1</sup> Contrary to West Side Neighbors' contentions, the certificate of variance was timely recorded within the ninety days after execution of the written order reflecting the grant of the variance, *see* 30-A M.R.S. § 4353(5) (2006), and the

technical defect of the proper Acting Secretary of the Board of Zoning Appeals signing a certificate in which a different Acting Secretary's name appeared in the body of the certificate does not render the variance void and subject to collateral attack. Accordingly, the Superior Court properly dismissed the complaint as untimely.
