MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Sarah Bridges appeals from a judgment of conviction of one count of forgery (Class D), 17-A M.R.S. § 703(1)(A) (2007), upon the District Court (Ellsworth, *Murray, R., J.*) finding her guilty. Contrary to Bridges's contention, we find, based on competent evidence in the record, that the court rationally could have found that Bridges acted with an intent to defraud. *See State v. Bates*, 2003 ME 67, ¶ 19, 822 A.2d 1129, 1134; *State v. Pinkham-Murch*, 432 A.2d 1297, 1300 (Me. 1981).
