MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

John J. Kelly appeals from a divorce judgment entered in the District Court (West Bath, Kennedy, M., J.) upon Kristina L. Kelly's complaint for divorce. Contrary to John's contentions, we find that the court did not commit clear error by finding irreconcilable differences between the parties, see Mattson v. Mattson, 376 A.2d 473, 475-76 (Me. 1977), and that the transcript of the hearing reflects that the court did allow John sufficient opportunity to present his opposition to a finding of irreconcilable differences. Finally, we decline to address whether the court erred, pursuant to 19-A M.R.S. § 902(2) (2007), by failing to order a continuance for marital counseling, as this issue is raised for the first time on appeal. See Teel v. Colson, 396 A.2d 529, 533 (Me. 1979).¹
