MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Denise Gray appeals from the divorce judgment of the District Court (Rumford, *McElwee*, *J*.). Contrary to Denise Gray's contentions, the record contains sufficient evidence to determine that the court did not err in finding that Roland Gray, represented by counsel, was competent to participate in the proceedings, that the parties' differences were irreconcilable, and that the marital share of improvements to Roland Gray's nonmarital residence was valued at \$5000 and should be divided equally. *In re Cyr*, 2005 ME 61, ¶ 16, 873 A.2d 355, 360-61; *State v. Cochran*, 2004 ME 138, ¶ 6, 863 A.2d 263, 265. Further, the court did not err or abuse its discretion in denying Denise Gray's motion for

appointment of a guardian ad litem and her attempts to require marital counseling. See 19-A M.R.S §§ 901(2), 902(2) (2007); see also Mattson v. Mattson, 376 A.2d 473, 476-77 (Me. 1977).
