MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Roland Scott appeals from the judgment of the District Court (Springvale, *Janelle, J.*) finding Scott in violation of the State automobile junkyard and graveyard laws, 30-A M.R.S. §§ 3751, 3752, 3753 (2007), the nuisance law, 17 M.R.S. § 2802 (2007), and the Town of Cornish Land Use Development Ordinance. Scott contends that the items on his property found to be violations were really materials used to support his farming operation and that the evidence was insufficient to support the court's judgment. No transcript of the trial was provided. Accordingly, we must infer that the record before the District Court fully supports the District Court's findings and discretionary decisions regarding

the violations of law and the remedy imposed. *Jefts v. Dennis*, 2007 ME 129, ¶ 7, 931 A.2d 1055, 1057.
