MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of Evan D. appeals from the judgment of the District Court (Bangor, *Gunther, J.*) terminating her parental rights to her son pursuant to 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2) (2008). Contrary to the mother's contentions, the record fully supports the court's findings, to the clear and convincing evidence standard, that return of the child to the mother would place the child at risk, that the mother will be unable to take responsibility for the child within a time reasonably calculated to meet the needs of the child, and that termination of parental rights is in the child's best interests. *See In re Marcus S.*, 2007 ME 24, ¶ 6, 916 A.2d 225, 227; *In re Thomas H.*, 2005 ME 123, ¶¶ 16-18, 889 A.2d 297, 301-02.
