MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Bruce Boyington appeals from the judgment of the District Court (Bangor, *Gunther, J.*) granting a final protection from abuse order, 19-A M.R.S. § 4007 (2008), and awarding temporary parental rights of the parties' daughter to Sarah Finch. The order limited Boyington's contact with the child to supervised contact arranged through third parties. Boyington contends that the record does not support limiting his contact with the child to visits supervised by a third party. Because no transcript of the proceedings or alternative statement of the evidence, *see* M.R. App. P. 5(d), has been filed in support of the appeal, we must infer that the record before the District Court supports the findings of fact and discretionary decisions reached by the court. *Jefts v. Dennis*, 2007 ME 129, ¶ 7, 931 A.2d 1055, 1057.
