MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of Yulinka R. appeals from the judgment of the District Court (Machias, *Romei*, *J*.) entered after hearing, terminating her parental rights pursuant to 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2) (2008). On appeal, the mother contends that the time allowed for reunification, before the termination of her parental rights, was not sufficient to permit her to attempt reunification with her child. Review of the record demonstrates that the child had been in DHHS custody for seven months before the Department filed a petition to terminate the mother's parental rights and that during that period, more than sufficient efforts were made to support the mother's reunification with her child despite the mother's failure or refusal to cooperate in those efforts. Further, contrary to the mother's contentions, the evidence fully supports, to the clear and convincing evidence standard, the court's findings in its judgment terminating parental rights. *In re Thomas H*, 2005 ME 123, ¶¶ 18-19, 23-30, 889 A.2d 297, 302, 303-08.
