MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Gary L. Ziegler appeals from a judgment entered in the District Court (York, O'Neil, J.) denying his motion to modify an order of child support, spousal support, and parental rights and responsibilities previously entered by the court Contrary to Ziegler's contentions, the court did not err in (Brodrick, J.). calculating child support, denying his motion to amend spousal support, or awarding shared primary residence of the daughter. See Smith v. Padolko, 2008 ME 56, ¶ 9, 955 A.2d 740, 743 ("We review an order on a post-divorce motion for abuse of discretion or other error of law."); see also Ellis v. Ellis, 2008 ME 191, ¶ 15, 962 A.2d 328, 333; Nadeau v. Nadeau, 2008 ME 147, ¶ 52, 957 A.2d 108, 122; Grenier v. Grenier, 2006 ME 99, ¶ 20, 904 A.2d 403, 408. In the absence of a motion for further findings of fact and conclusions of law pursuant to M.R. Civ. P. 52(a), it may be inferred that the trial court made all the findings necessary to support its judgment, if the record supports those findings. Lyons v. Baptist Sch. of Christian Training, 2002 ME 137, ¶ 13, 804 A.2d 364, 369. Competent evidence in the record supports the court's judgment.
