MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Bonny Shay appeals from a judgment entered by the Superior Court (Hancock County, *Brodrick, J.*) after a nonjury trial, finding her guilty of aggravated assault (Class B), 17-A M.R.S. § 208(1)(B) (2008); driving to endanger (Class C), 29-A M.R.S. § 2413(1-A) (2008); and reckless conduct (Class C), 17-A M.R.S. §§ 211, 1252(4) (2008). Contrary to Shay's contention, the evidence, when viewed in the light most favorable to the State, was sufficient for the court to find that Shay acted recklessly. 17-A M.R.S. § 35(3) (2008); *State v. Gorman*, 648 A.2d 967, 967-68 (Me. 1994).
